About the EUI

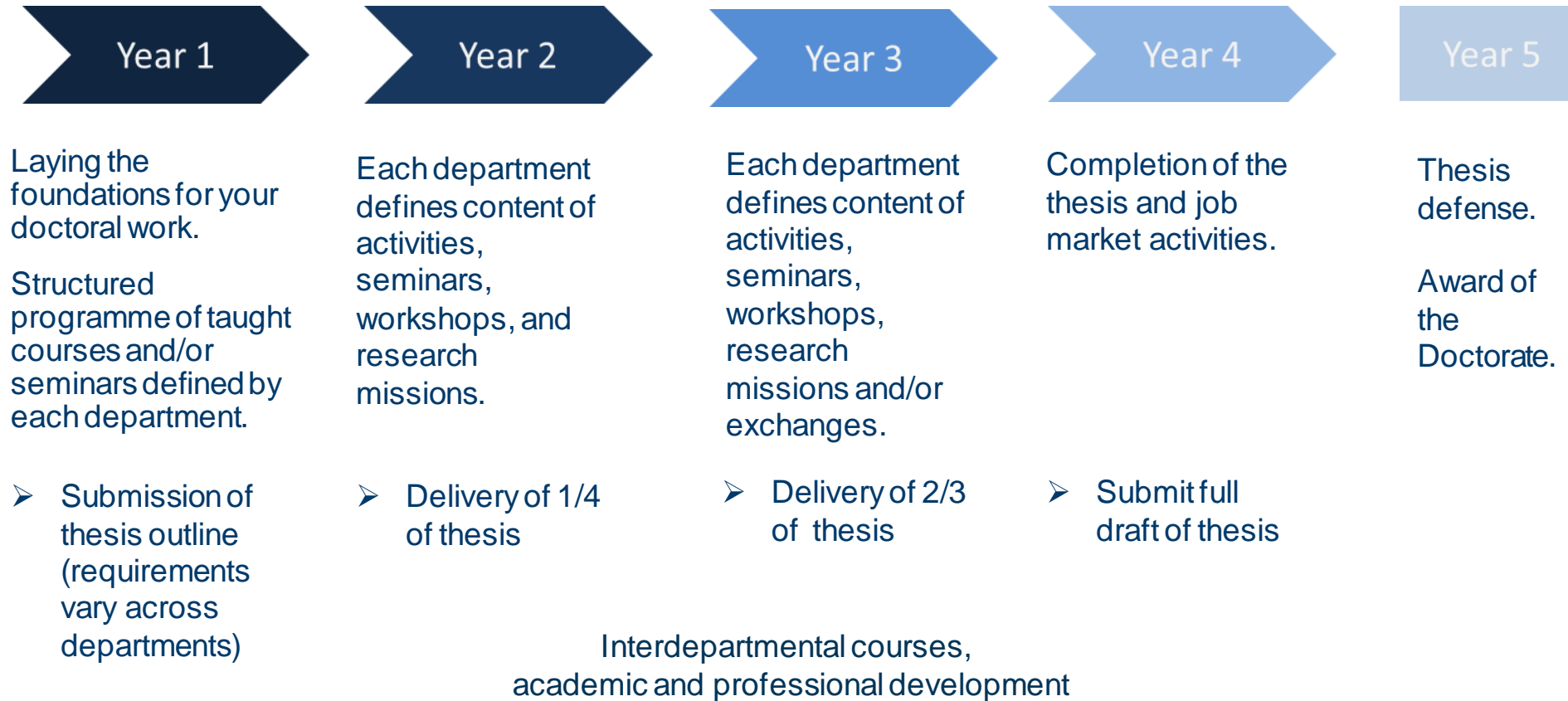
- Founded in 1972 by the six original member states of the European Communities: Benelux, France, Germany (FRG), and Italy

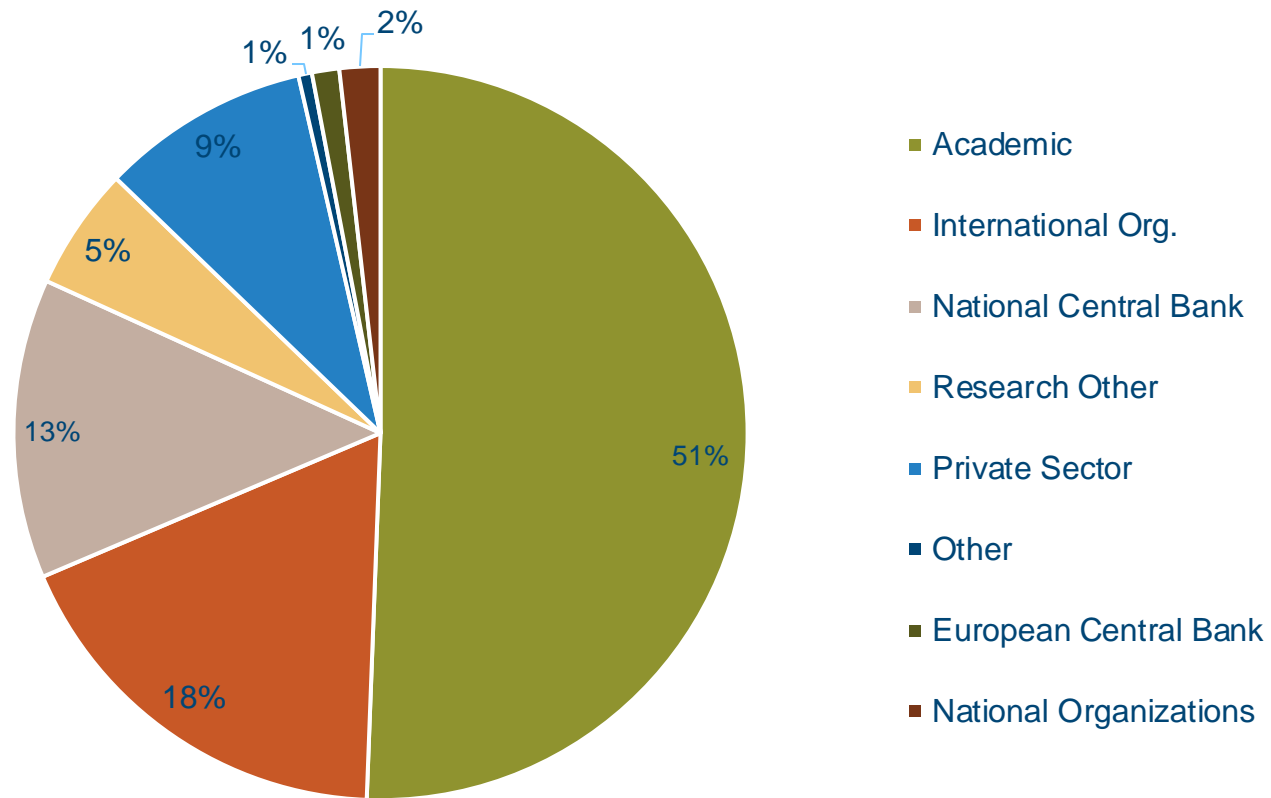
- Close supervision with regular monitoring to assess teaching and quality of supervision

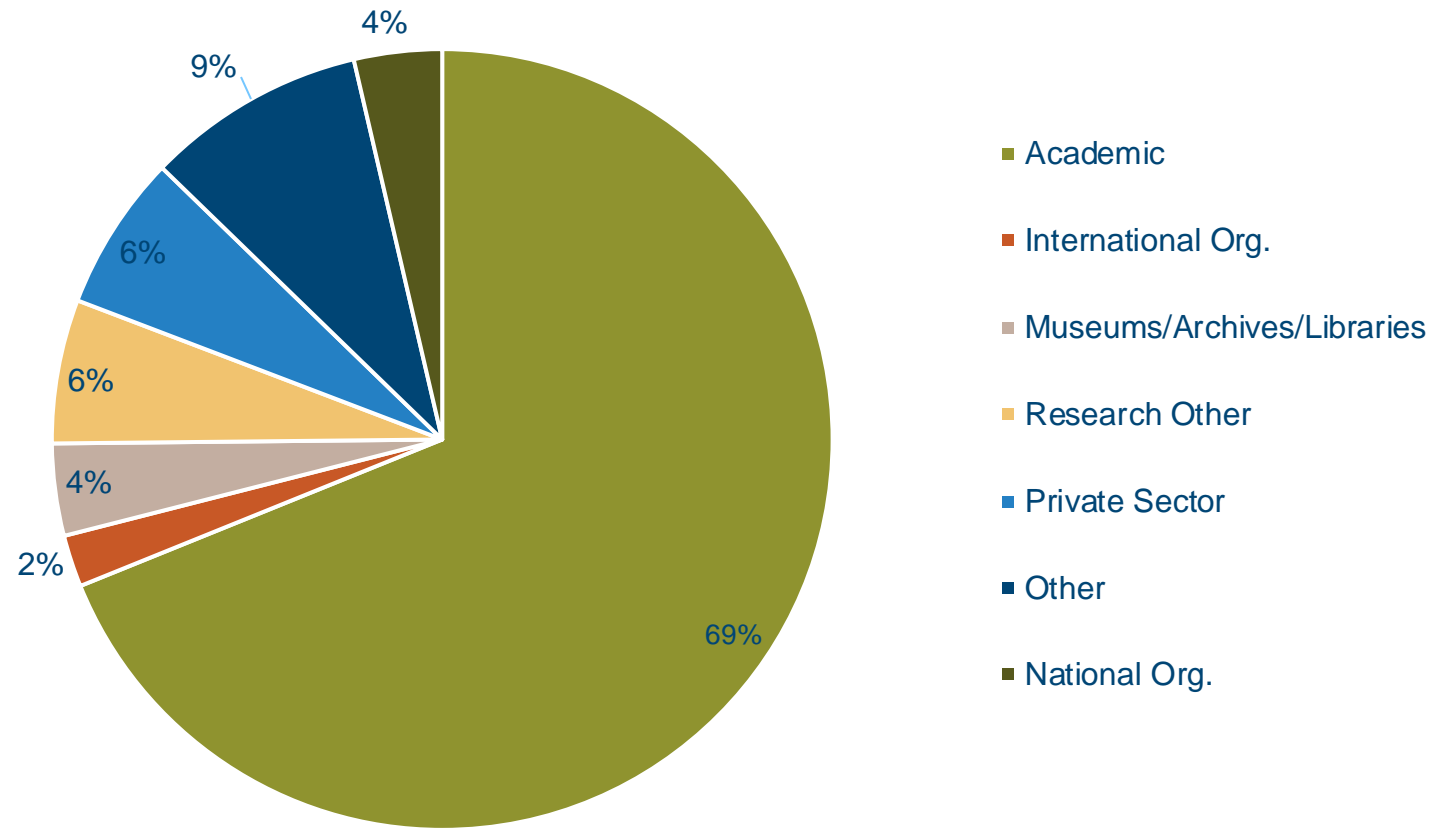

Current employment of ECO alumni

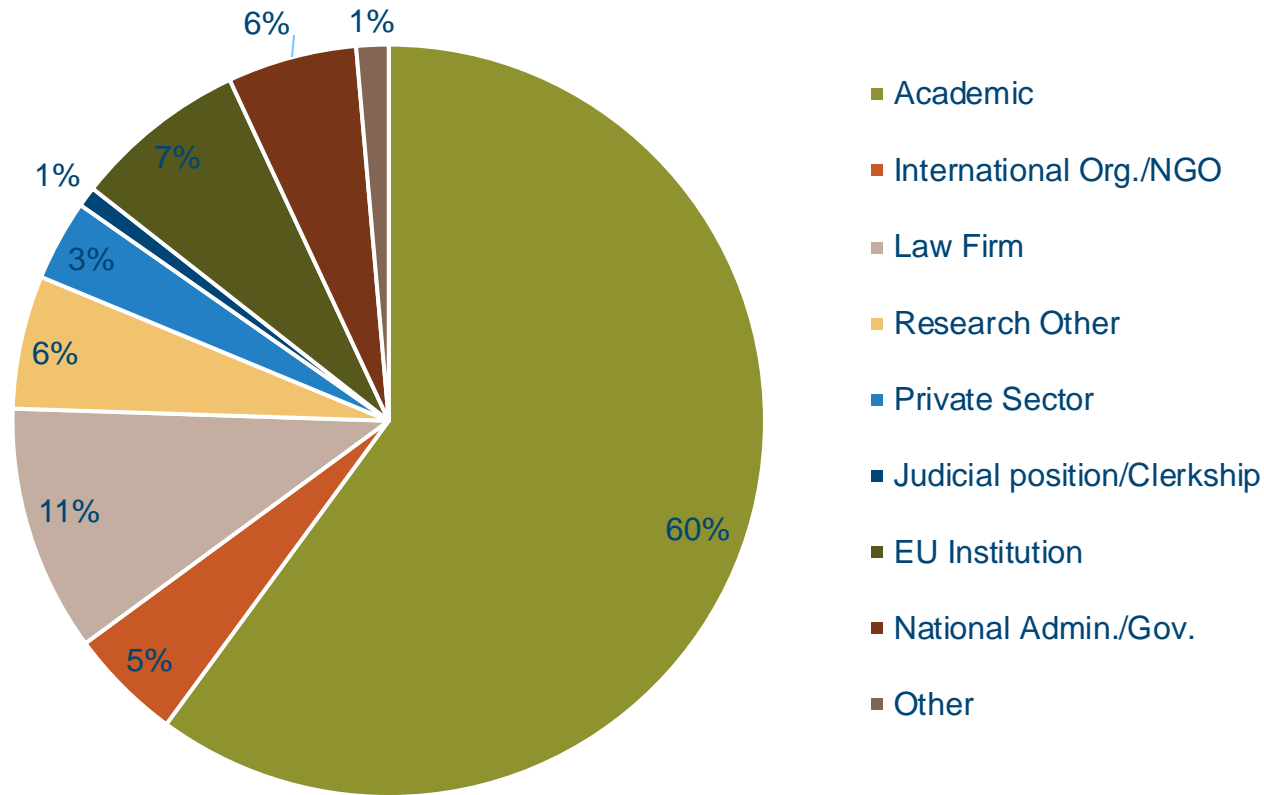


Current employment of HEC alumni

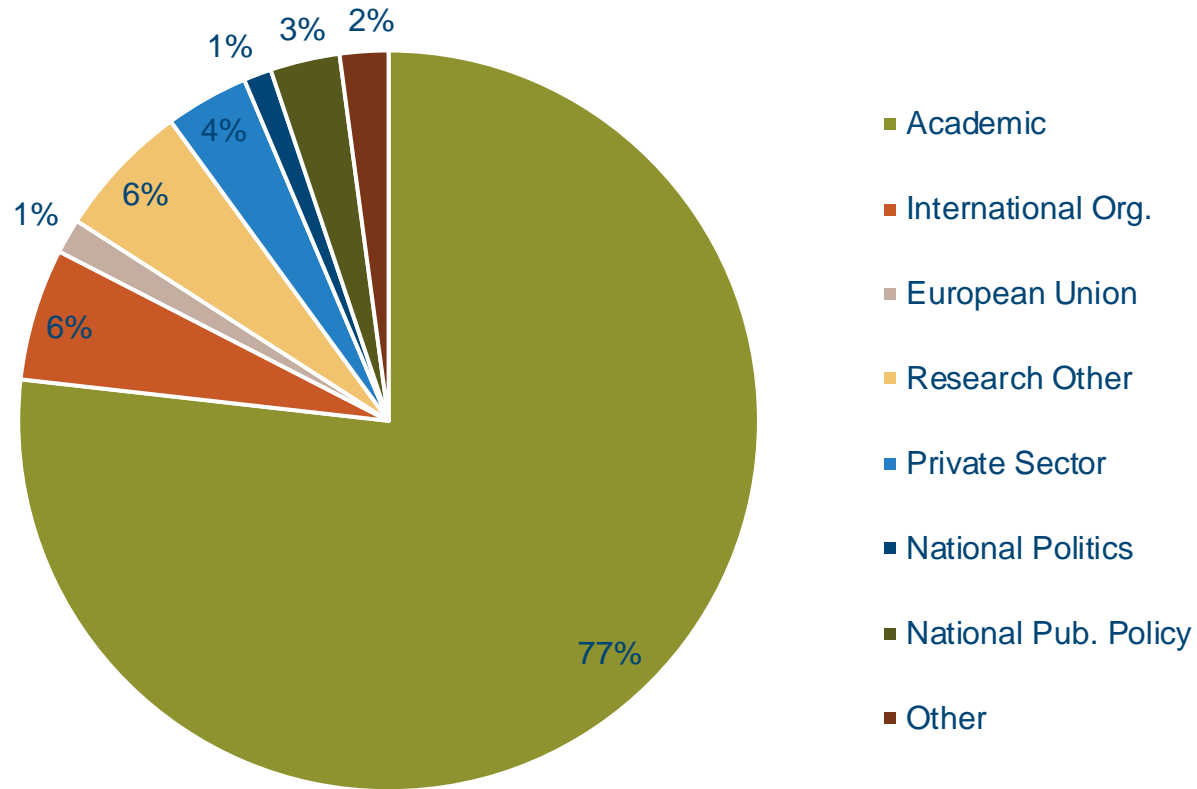

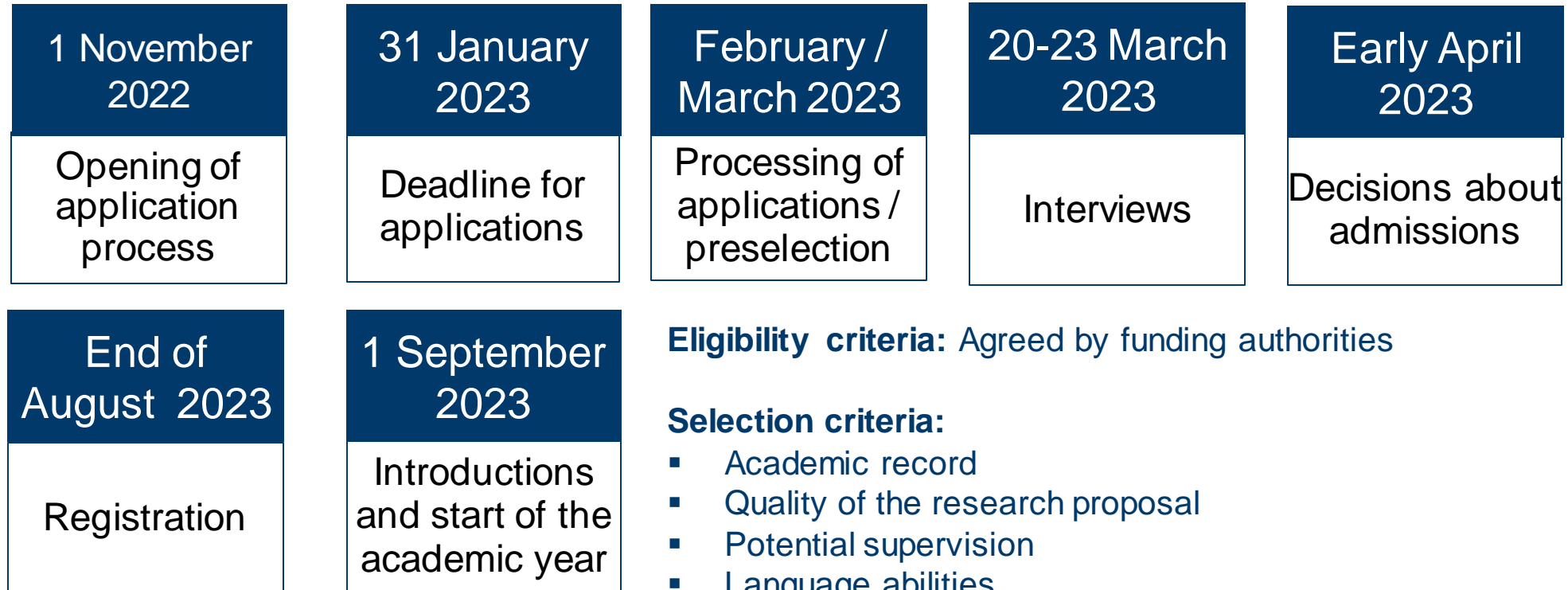
